

NON – RATED CLASS DEFINITIONS

FINE HARNESS/ CART/ CARRIAGE/ WAGON CLASS

This class will Showcase those fine horse vehicles including, but not limited to carriages and fancy carts.

May be pulled by one or two horses.

WESTERN COUNTRY PLEASURE DRIVING CLASS

This class will show the country horse that you would take down the dirt road for a nice quiet drive in the country.

The Head carriage shall be no more than four inches above the weathers.

Over flex of the neck shall be penalized. Gaits will be the same as in the Open Country Pleasure Driving class.

Knee action shall be penalized.

Cannot cross over between Country Pleasure or Pleasure Driving classes.

PEE WEE CLASSES

These classes are for youth 7 years and under. Mare and geldings only can be shown. They may show in regular youth classes also. The classes are geared toward out youngest exhibitors, to give them a chance to enter the show ring with an adult who can give them verbal instructions when necessary. Classes offered, PeeWee Halter, PeeWee Showmanship, PeeWee Jumping and PerWee Halter Obstacle.

FUN PAYBACK CLASSES

Wheelbarrow Olympics; Test your skills while maneuvering a wheelbarrow through a barnyard chore course. No horse is needed for this, just people.

Halter Brigade; You'll need a team of three people, one horse and three halters and leads.

Cloverleaf; A Favorite. A game of speed to see which horse and handler can make it around the barrels the fastest.

Pickup Race; Consists of a two person team & a cart. No horse needed

Super Showmanship; A Showmanship pattern with an added degree of difficulty.
